Transfer Student Acceptances:

Congrats to our students who have transferred successfully to universities in the US & Canada. Our acceptances for Fall 2016 include University of the Fraser Valley (UFV), Stephen F. Austin University (SFA) & State University of New York Plattsburgh (SUNY).

The **University Transfer Program** is one of the most important and popular offerings at ACD. It enables UAE-based students to complete in Dubai much of the basic coursework required by all universities abroad in almost every academic area of choice, before physically transferring to the university overseas or in the UAE from which they intend to earn a degree.

Students begin classes at ACD, complete one or two years and then transfer the credits earned at ACD to degree-granting institutions in the USA and other countries, including the UAE if they want to remain closer to home.

Transfer Agreements with ACD:


The American College of Dubai has a comprehensive transfer articulation agreement with the prestigious UFV in Canada and SFA in Texas U.S.A. The agreement allows for the smooth transfer of ACD students to UFV and SFA after completing one or two years of their university degree program. Students who take advantage of the "2+2" option could save over \$50,000 in tuition fees as well as living expenses in the USA and Canada.

ACD was delighted to welcome Ravi Phillips, Head of International Marketing (Asia, Middle East and Africa) at UFV and Heather Cotton, Director of International Programs at SFA during the month of February 2016. They were both able to meet with many prospective students.



UFV and SFA offer a full range of Business, Economics and Arts Degrees. Both universities are excellent choices due to quality of education and affordable tuition. Successful applicants to SFA would be awarded merit based scholarship up to \$9,500 a year! UFV also has a number of international scholarships. The total UFV annual fees including accommodation is approximately \$18,000.

On the 11th of Feb 2016, thirteen AS level students of Business Studies from The Westminster School, Dubai participated in the competition for developing entrepreneurial skills at the American College of Dubai. They were given one hour and thirty minutes to complete their task.
